We also undertake research and identify workable policy alternatives and bring them to the attention of policy-makers. Our home, Quaker House Brussels is a much-loved “safe space” at the heart of the European Quarter, where a wide range of actors meet in a comfortable, discreet setting, to speak freely and listen deeply to each other.

Migration and peace

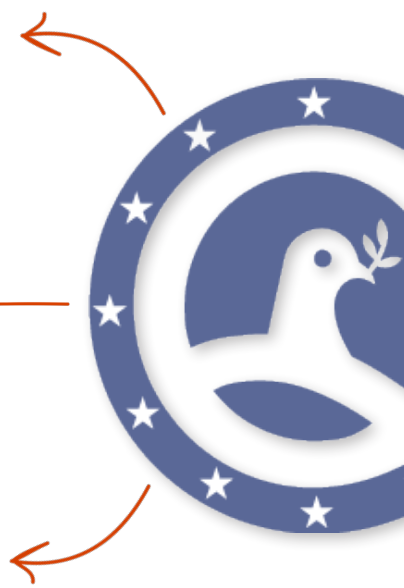
QCEA seeks to create policy conditions to support safe, equitable and responsive migration systems that contribute to long-term, sustainable peace.

Dialogues for transformation

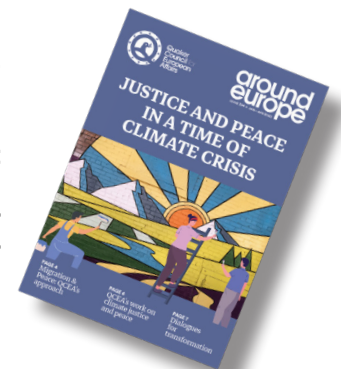
QCEA enables dialogue across differences, supporting people to listen deeply and gain new perspective on issues that are stuck or highly polarised.
